- Discarded Household Appliances
 - Air Conditioners
 - Clothes Washers and Dryers
 - Conventional Ovens
 - Dehumidifiers
 - Dishwashers
 - Freezers
 - Heat Pumps
 - Ranges
 - Refrigerators
 - Stoves
 - Trash Compactors
 - Water Heaters
 - Wood Stoves



- Slate Shingles and Siding
- Any items over eight (8) feet in length.
- Burn Barrels
- Lead-Acid Batteries, Auto Batteries
- Unregulated Household Waste
 - Paint
 - Antifreeze
 - Pesticides, etc.



- Waste Oil/Motor Oil (See Used Oil Collection Program)
 - Cooking Oil banned as recyclable, accepted as MSW
- Waste Tires (In Any Form Per State Reg. 9-1-98)
- Waste Tires (Whole)



PAINT

Per State laws, the City MSW Transfer Station and garbage companies cannot take paint in its original form. Mix the paint with cheap kitty litter or floor dry, stir mixture and keep the lid off. This will harden the paint, so you can then put it out with your regular garbage to be hauled away and be disposed.
