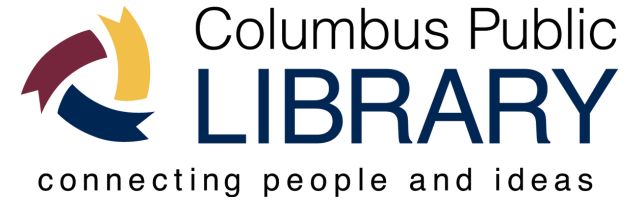

What is Teen Library Council?

Teen Library Council, or TLC, is a group of teens that meet once a month during the school year at the Columbus Public Library. TLC will essentially be the brains behind our teen library programs.

When is TLC?

We will meet once per month during the first Thursday of the month. The meetings will be held at the Columbus Public Library. Meetings will be 1 hour long.

Who is eligible?
